Mark 5:25-29

“And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years. She had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, yet instead of getting better she grew worse. When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak, because she thought, “If I just touch his clothes, I will be healed.” Immediately her bleeding stopped and she felt in her body that she was freed from her suffering.”

As I began to reflect on the story about the woman with the issue of blood, I think of how she hemorrhaged for many years, and when she touched the hem of Jesus’ garment, her bleeding stopped; she was healed immediately. This story should be of encouragement, because when we don’t see that things are looking so well, and when we don’t know how to move beyond our physical circumstance into the realm of faith, our thoughts should be that in Jesus lies everything that I need!!

This story is talking about faith and we are living in a time now that we need to really walk by faith and not by sight. It’s not about what we see, because the enemy will always paint a picture to make us think that we will never come out of what we are in. The enemy’s job is to keep you doubled over with the cares of this world and what’s going on in your life, because his job is to kill, steal, and destroy. But God said that I come that you might have life and that

you shall have it more abundantly.

Looking at this story, this woman was considered an outcast because of her condition. According to the Levitical law, she was prohibited from entering the temple or coming into human contact. She was labeled unclean. She was alone, isolated, abandoned, rejected, an outcast, broken, defiled and destitute. Years of shame left her broken, stripped of any self-worth and a proper identity. Since she was unclean, she should have been prohibited from being around, let alone touching anyone. She was not allowed to be out in public. But we see a desperate woman that didn’t care if they beat her up, she didn’t care if they stoned her or killed her. She was saying there’s a man that I just have to get to. She was saying if only I can get to this man called Jesus! This woman had desperation and determination. In spite of all of her issues, her “problem” pushed her into the presence of God. She didn’t sit and wait for her physical issue to be met, she went to meet it—she was desperate and driven. She made her way through the crowd, and pressed toward the source of her healing. She chose to no longer remain in her dark and lonely pit. She put it all on the line, reached out to Jesus and was immediately healed.

The devil will always try to make you think that you can’t be healed or that what you’ve done can’t be forgiven, but the devil is a liar. Romans 8:1 says *“There is therefore now no condemnation to them that are in Christ Jesus.”* No matter what you’ve done, no matter what issue you may have, if you have repented and are in Christ Jesus.....whom the Son sets free is free indeed. You have to realize that you cannot allow anything or anyone to dis-



tract you from getting into the presence of God. That means, that no matter what is going on in your life, you must maintain an attitude of praise. Just like this woman, she was at a point of thinking, I just got to get to Jesus. You have to understand that God wants to heal those broken and wounded areas in your life.

You have to change your way of thinking. Quit thinking that you can’t make it. Quit thinking that you’re not strong enough. You have to realize that His strength is made perfect in your weakness. And some people have gotten weak in their faith. You have to keep the mindset that if God said it, it has to happen. If God says it, then it is so.

It doesn’t matter how long you’ve been going through your problems. What matters is that once you touch Jesus, you are made whole and healed from those old issues. You will be healed from every disease, healed from every hurt and pain; you will be set free from everything that the enemy said you would never achieve in your life. You will be loosed from doubt. You will be loosed from your fears. You will be loosed from your past. You will be loosed of everything that the devil has done in your life. **YOU WILL BE LOOSED! YOU SHALL BE FREE!** All you have to do is be determined to touch Jesus and let Him change your life!

PRAYER CHANGES EVERYTHING!

Our God hears every prayer and no prayer goes unanswered; God has timing for everything even answering prayers, what we have to

learn is how to pray His promises. The promises of God should be what we pray; in other words we must go to God with His own promises.

When we pray for answers to situations in our lives, healing for a family member or friend, revival in the church or the salvation of a sinner, we must go to the Word for God's Will and then look for the promise in that connection. We must then STAND on those promises! In Jeremiah 33:19-27 God says His promises (to David) are steadfast as sunrise and sunset, just as sure as the sun will rise and the sun will set my promise are so. In the book of Numbers 23:19 it says that "God is not a man that He should lie nor a son of man that He should change His mind; if God said it then it's a done deal!

It's just that simple, pray His promises! Here are a few promises from His word that we

can begin to add to our daily prayer life:

God keeps His promises

God is not a man that He should lie, nor the son of man that He should change His mind (Num. 23:19); Heb. 10:23; Isa. 45:11; Ps. 89:34-36; Isa. 30:18

God hears our prayer

For the Eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and His Ears are attentive their prayers (1Pet. 3:12) Ps. 34:17; 1John 5:14; 2 Cron. 16:9; Ps. 4:4; Ps. 102:17

God answers our prayer

Before they call I will answer; while they are still speaking I will hear (Isa. 65:24) Jer. 33:3; Mark 11:24; John 16:24; John 15:7; Isa. 58:9; Eph.3:20; Matt. 7:7

Promises about Faith in God

Think of yourself...in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you (Rom. 12:3) Eph. 2:8; Heb. 11:6; James 1:3; 1 Pet. 1:7; Rom. 1:17; 1 John 5:4; Mark 9:23; Eph. 6:16; John 20:29; Matt. 21:21-22; John 16:24

Promises about forgiveness

If we confess our sins He is Faithful and Just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9) Ps. 32:1-2; Isa. 43:25; Ps. 103:12; 1 John 2:12; Eph. 1:7; Rom. 8:33

Promises about Spiritual Growth

Being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus (Phil. 1:6) John 17:18-19; 2 Pet. 1:3-4; 2 Cor. 3:18; 1 Cor. 1:8; Eph. 3:17-19; Phil. 1:9-10

Promises about the Love of God

But God demonstrates His own Love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Rom. 5:8) Jer. 31:3; Isa. 54:10; 1 John 4:9-10; John 15:9; 1 John 3:1

God will give us the desires of our heart

May He give you the desires of your heart and make all your plans succeed (Ps. 20:4) Ps. 21:2; Prov. 10:24; Ps. 103:4-5; Mark 11:24

Promises about health and healing

By His wounds we are healed (Isa. 53:5c) Jer. 30:17; Deut. 7:12, 15; Ps. 91:5-6, 10; 3 John 1:2; Jer. 38:6; Ex. 15: 25-26; Ps. 103:3; Mal. 4:2; 1 Pet. 2:24; James 5:13-14,16; Matt. 8:16-17

These are just a few of the promises in the Word of God concerning us; search the scriptures and you will find that everything you need, want and desire is promised! You will even discover your purpose! Began to pray the promises of God; tarry at those promises and watch God show up!
